STRENGTHEN

We strengthen the capacity of practitioners and organisations to design and implement effective, feminist-inspired prevention programmes. Through training and technical support, we promote programming that is sustainable, high-quality and grounded in best practice.



SYNTHESISE

We critically review and curate emerging research and practice-based knowledge, distilling insights useful for practitioners.



INNOVATE

We promote proven but under-utilised prevention strategies, and harness policy reform and technology to achieve violence reduction at scale.



CONNECT

We shape the global prevention ecosystem by linking research and practice, bridging the fields of violence against women and violence against children, and working across disciplines and geographies.

OUR WORK

We have spent years developing and refining the approaches, tools, and relationships that make effective prevention possible. We are expanding our work, building on these foundations. That means continuing to grow our core capacity-strengthening offers—**Cluster Programme**, which brings cohorts of organisations together for structured peer learning; **Accompaniment Programme**, which pairs organisations one-on-one with a prevention mentor over time; and **Strategic Advisory Services**, which offer bespoke technical support.

Alongside these, we are leading **innovation** at the intersection of **prevention** and technology, championing policy and legal reform as strategies governments can use to drive **reductions in violence at scale**, and **expanding** gender-transformative parenting and family-strengthening approaches, particularly with faith-based organisations and communities.

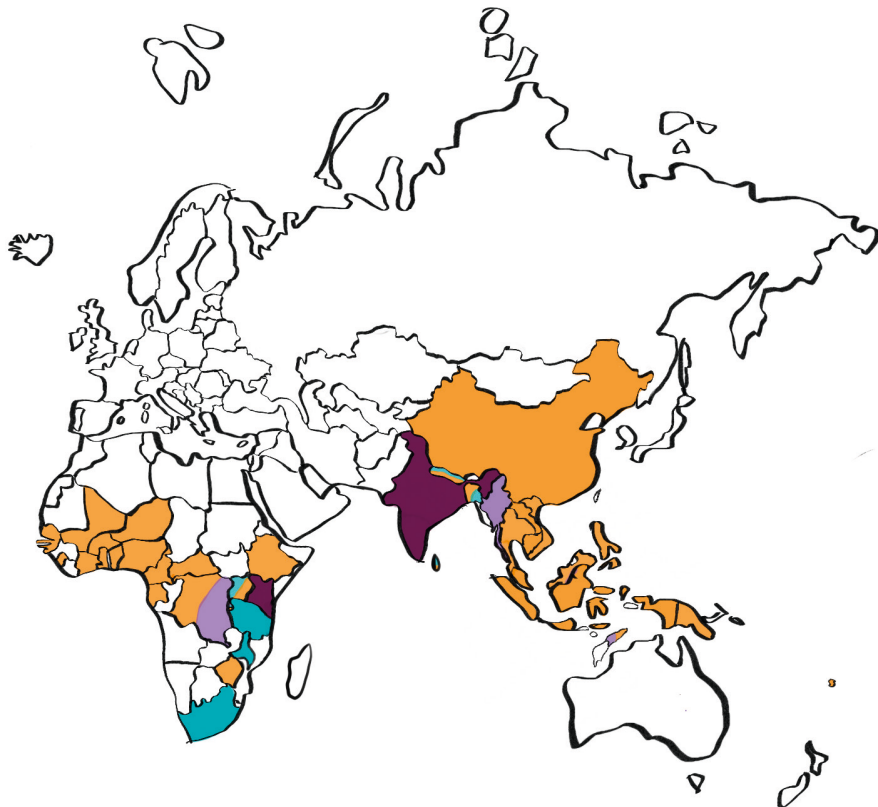
